NOTICE REGARDING ONLINE APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO 1st SEMESTER SESSION 2021-22

- Online applications are invited from students (female) who have qualified 10+2, to take admission in the B.A. / B.SC 1st semester in Malda Women's College affiliated to the University of Gour Banga.
- The college offers Honours and General Courses in the following subjects:
1. English 2. Bengali 3. Education 4. Economics 5. Geography 6. History 7. Philosophy 8. Political Science 9. Sociology 10. Sanskrit 11. Women's Studies (only General).
- The college offers admission in Online Mode only. No offline applications will be accepted.
- Each application form allows a candidate to apply for maximum of 4 Honours subjects and 1 General course.
- A candidate can choose to apply for Honours and General course together in the same form or can apply for either Honours or General course based on their choice but not exceeding a maximum of 4 Honours subject and 1 General course.

The schedule of the online admission procedure is as follows: (UGB Circular No. 341/UGB/DR-2021

Date: 22.07.2021)

- a. Date of online application begins from: 02.08.2021 (11.00 a.m.)
- b. Last date for online application: 20.08.2021 (midnight)
- c. Publication of Provisional merit list: 25.08.2021 (12 noon)
- d. Last date for correction of mistakes / errors in Provisional merit list: 28.08.2021 (midnight)
- e. Publication of Final merit list (online)-Hons and General: 31.08.2021 (11.00 a.m.)
- f. Commencement of different phases of E-counselling & Online Admission : 01.09.2021 (Detailed schedule of e-counseling will be published later)
- g. Closing date of entire Online Admission Procedure : 30/09/2021

Eligibility Criteria:

1. General (Unreserved) and OBC: (Hons.): At least 45% marks in aggregate. If a student fails to get at least 45% marks in aggregate, she has to get at least 40% marks in aggregate and at least 50% marks in the subject opted for Honours.
2. SC & STs: (Hons.): At least 40% marks in aggregate. If a student fails to get at least 40% marks in aggregate, she has to get at least 35% marks in aggregate and at least 45% marks in the subject opted for Honours.
3. A) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:
Subject (opted for Honours) + Grand Total

B) In case any candidate opts for an Honours beyond his subject combination (Except linguistic subject) at H.S. (10+2) Level, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:
0(Zero) + Grand Total
6
4. Merit Points will be deducted for candidates passing the 10+2 examination in 2020 @ 5% and in 2019 @ 10%.
5. Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Courses will be prepared on the basis of Grand Total of best of five subjects.
6. Candidates qualifying in 10+2 examination with English in vocational mode can apply only in General course.
7. Student passing out only from the State Level and National Level Boards in regular mode will be allowed to take admission in Hons / General Course.

Payment:

1. Students must pay the admission fees in ONLINE MODE.
- N.B.: Students are instructed to fill up the application forms properly. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
